



Since 1992 Mr Munchi Choksey, FRCS has worked as an independent Consultant Neurosurgeon. Munchi has performed over 2,000 intracranial procedures, including clipping of 400 aneurysms. In particular he carries out a large number of revision spinal procedures in patients who have had previous spinal surgery elsewhere. This often involves spinal fusion, which may need to be done from the back or front. Munchi carries out over 200 lumbar spinal procedures and approximately 50 cervical spinal procedures a year.

Mr Choksey has a very wide experience of all aspects of clinical neurosurgery. In addition, he acts as an examiner for [The Royal College of Surgeons](#) in Surgical Neurology and has done so for ten years. He is a recognised expert witness, preparing reports for both the Plaintiff and the Defendant.
